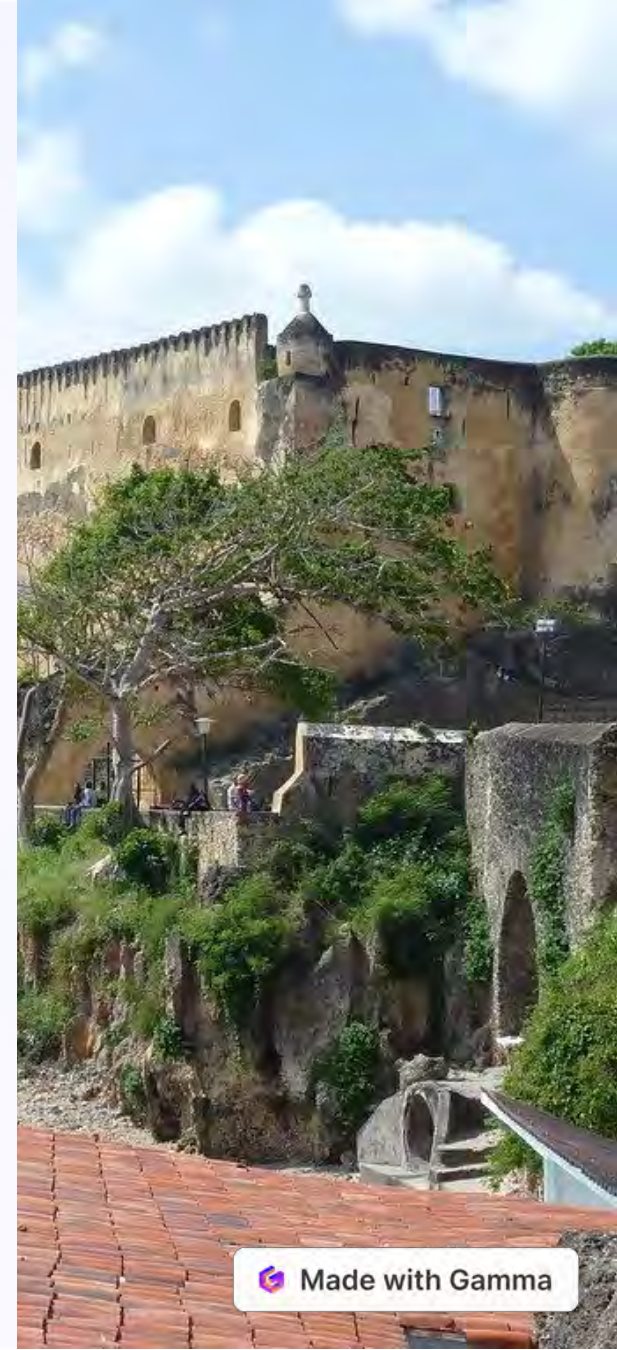
### Historical Visit.
